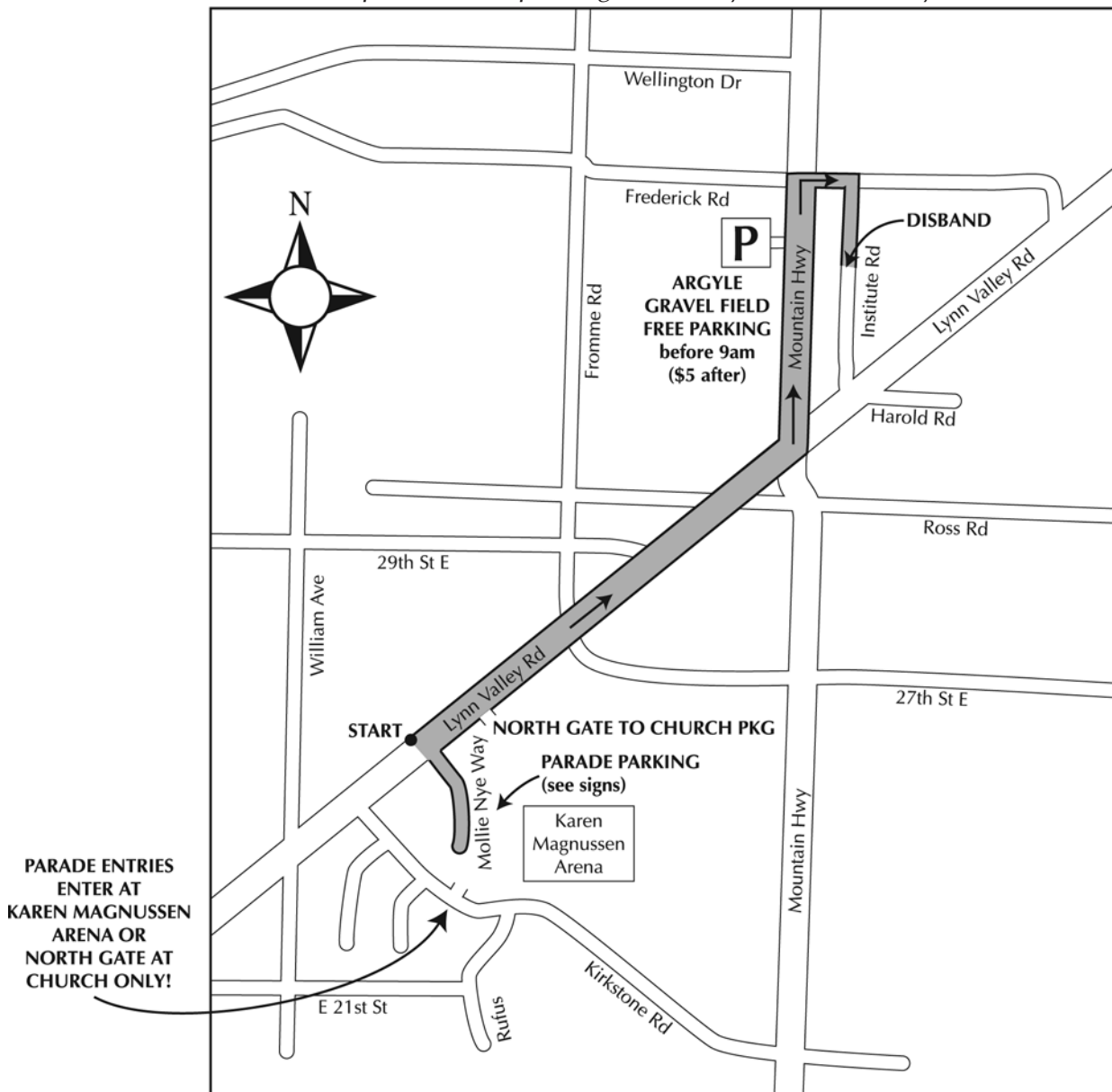

DEFINITIONS

FLOAT... A Float is anything being pulled by a vehicle or self-propelled wagon.

DECORATED CAR... A car is defined as a vehicle requiring a standard automobile license to operate.

WALKING... Walking Entries are defined as any group walking through the Parade with similar dress style, synchronized movement, or organized choreography.

ANIMAL ENTRIES... Any Parade entry that consists of animals. Each animal is required to have a clean-up crew. All animals must be controlled by means of a harness, halter, or leash if otherwise not contained. Animals may by no means be cruelly exploited, endangered or abused in the process of this entry. For example, it is OK to properly ride on a horse, but not OK to have an animal in a cage on display,

POLITICAL ENTRIES... This entry is defined as an entry into the parade that represents a political party and is participating in the parade for political gain, such as being elected to office. This entry is not eligible for cash or community prizes.

Candidates for political office will give **NO** speeches.

All entries will be judged and prize money will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- **Best Theme Interpretation**
- **Most Creative**
- **Most Original**
- **Best Appearance**

SAFETY RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Parade Officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is deemed inappropriate, unsafe and illegal.
2. The Parade & lineup will begin at Mollie Nye Way @ the church parking lot/Lynn Valley Rd.
3. Parade marshalling begins @ 8:15am Entrants should be in the lineup no later than 9:15am for judging- the Parade will begin promptly at 10:00am
4. Your entry may not EXIT the Parade before the end of the Parade.
5. Candy is a tradition at the Parade: Please ensure that candy is the wrapped kind. (i. e. gum, hard candy, freezies, etc.) Please hand it out, do not throw into crowd so children do not come out into the road and risk the possibility of running in front of a vehicle, bike or skateboard etc.
6. Entries with children under the age of 16 must have adult supervision.
7. All entries must have clear identification signage.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Please be informed that the Lynn Valley Lions will be having the annual Parade Saturday, May 28th, 2011. Entries will line up along Mollie Nye Way & the adjacent church parking lot (Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints).

Parade Entries enter through the entrance to Karen Magnussen Arena and the north gate of the Church (Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints) on Lynn Valley Road/Mollie Nye Way.

Lynn Valley Road/Mountain Hwy will close at approx 9:40am for the Parade and re-open at approx 11:30am.

Parade moves east on Lynn Valley Road (south side). North side will be coned for 2 way bus traffic **only**. Barricades will be set up at side streets along Lynn Valley Road.

Parking for Parade entries is **only** at the north side of Karen Magnussen Arena, east of Mollie Nye Way, directly between the Arena and tennis courts (see signs).

Parade moves off at 10:00am sharp, rain or shine.
